### N.Y. Dropping Regents Exams as a Graduation Requirement

Under <u>a looming overhaul</u> outlined in June, students would no longer be required to pass the state's Regents exams to earn a high school diploma.

Instead, the exams would be among a slew of options for demonstrating proficiency in key areas, including project-based assessments, work-based learning experiences, and more.

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) has presented a timeline and implementation plan to change graduation requirements for students.

The plan aligns with recommendations made by the New York State Blue Ribbon Commission on Graduation Measures, which were designed to bring greater equity within the state's education system.

According to the state's proposed timeline, changes to graduation requirements would first take effect in fall 2027.






